Making a Difference Through the PACT Act

A Vietnam-era Navy Veteran filed his first VA disability claim in December 2015 and was granted a 10% rating for hearing loss. This Veteran also had prostate cancer, and upon learning that his service in Guam covered under the PACT Act, he filed a new claim for service connection on March 31, 2022. On February 16, 2023, his claim was granted and his disability rating increased from 10% to a combined rating of 100%, backdated to August 10, 2022 -- the day the PACT Act was signed into law. The Veteran received a lump sum retroactive award on February 21, 2023. This is life-changing for the Veteran and his family, and he is happy to share his story to encourage other Veterans to apply for the care and benefits they deserve.


Toxic Exposure Screenings where Veterans Endorsed at least one Potential Exposure









The screening will ask Veterans if they think they were exposed to any of these hazards while serving: Open burn pits and other airborne hazards, Gulf War-related exposures, Agent Orange Radiation, Camp Lejeune contaminated water exposure and/or Other Exposures
